Heritage

Château Tanunda, Icon of the Barossa, was established in 1890 and is the site of some of the Valley's earliest vines as well as its first winery. The Château is privately owned by the Geber family who continue a tradition of fine winemaking spanning three centuries.

Philosophy

The Tower is the grand entrance to The Château and the Barossa Tower range is your gateway to a contemporary selection of wines for everyday drinking, from both classic and new varieties, highlighting the Barossa's rich diversity.

Winemaking

This unique blend is sourced from our grower's vineyards throughout the Barossa and its myriad sub- regions. It is this tapestry of "terroirs" which enables us to create our classic and refined house style. The grapes were de- stemmed but not crushed and were fermented separately with regular hand plunging and pumping over to gently extract colour, flavours and tannins. This is followed by careful basket pressing and malolactic fermentation in a combination of new and seasoned American and French oak barrels prior to maturation in our cellars.

Tasting Note

The Shiraz displays lifted aromas of blackberry, plum and black pepper with spicy, dark berry fruits on the palate and the Primitivo adds vibrant cranberry, raspberry and strawberry flavours.
